



# Oak and Resin Serving Boards

## Care Instructions

THANK YOU for purchasing one of our stunning and unique serving boards. We hope you get many years of use and pleasure from it.

Your board is a unique product made from reclaimed Oak and bio-resin.

Reclaimed floorboards are cleaned, planed, a colourful stripe of bio-based Epoxxy resin is added and then hand shaped. Each piece comes from a limited batch with unique grain, handle positions and colours.



The board may need “Buffing” with a soft cloth to restore the evenness of the satin finish which can be dulled during storage and transport.

The finish on your board is Clark’s Cutting Board Wax which is 100% plant based.

### Care of Your Board

Simply wipe clean with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh cleaning products, but a little soap is ok. Occasional re-oiling will return the finish to good as new.

Just give your board a coat of cutting board wax or oil. We think it’s best not to use fossil fuel based mineral oil, which is why we use a coconut oil and beeswax.

Oils from the kitchen cupboard are not suitable, they can go rancid. Use a professional, food safe, board product.

**Resin-** The Epoxxy resin used is robust but is not resistant to scratches and excessive heat. Surface scratches can be buffed out with a cutting compound such as Novus plastic polish.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Dust and buff with a soft clean cloth.</i></li><li>• <i>Clean with a damp cloth.</i></li><li>• <i>Use soap sparingly.</i></li><li>• <i>Keep out of strong sunlight.</i></li><li>• <i>Use natural Wax or plant oil finishes</i></li><li>• <i>Remove Spillages immediately</i></li><li>• <i>Store away from direct sunlight.</i></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Use knives on the resin</i></li><li>• <i>Use oils from the kitchen cupboard.</i></li><li>• <i>Use strong or silicone-based polish or cleaners.</i></li><li>• <i>Place near excessive heat or flame.</i></li><li>• <i>Stand anything hot directly on the surface.</i></li><li>• <i>Use alcohol, spirit or acetone-based products</i></li></ul>

**Wood-** Marks in the wood can be removed by light sanding with 120 and then 240 grit sandpaper before oiling.

**Colour Change** – All wood products will change in shade slightly as its exposed to sunlight. This is perfectly normal.
